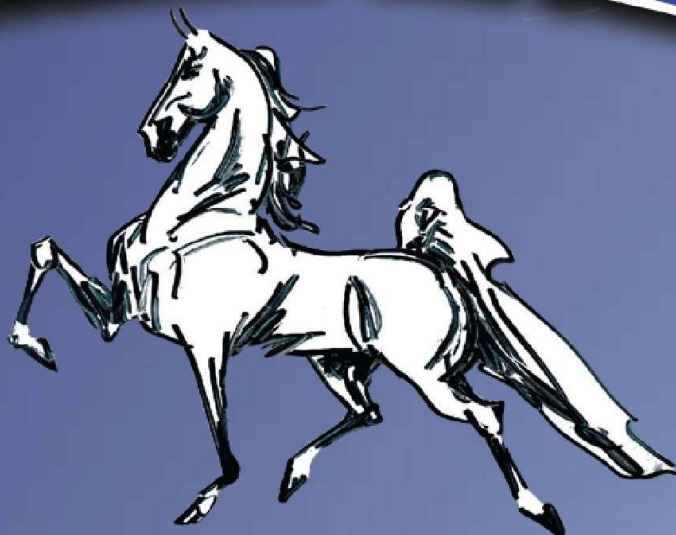

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Entries:** Closing date for entries is May 25 and an open check is acceptable for entries only. Any entries not paid in full or received after the closing date (except stake and championship classes) will be considered Post Entries. Post Entries will be accepted at \$25.00 per Horse. Show management reserves the right to refuse any and all entries or to return any money paid for stalls or entry fees without explanation or recourse to the show for liability or compensation. Returned checks will be assessed \$25.00 for each redeposit and \$50.00 if a check cannot be presented to a bank as a cash item.
- 2. Stalls:** Stalls will be available from Sunday, June 23 through Sunday, June 30 at \$150.00 per stall (temporary stabling facilities need to be vacated by 2:00 P.M.). If you plan to arrive prior to Sunday, June 23, or need to stay over past Sunday, June 30 at 2:00 P.M., please call Dan Shirley (864-630-1669) or Janie Hamilton (214-478-0897). All stall fees must be paid in full by the closing date May 25 (an open check is acceptable). Stall fees are not refundable. Stalls will be assigned by the show management to most efficiently use available stalls.
- 3. Tent Damage:** Tents (including the valance) must not be damaged or altered in any manner (i.e.: cut, punctured, rods, or tie chains adjusted or removed, etc.). Damages will be charged to the exhibitor occupying the damaged portion of the tent.
- 4. Bedding:** Bedding will be available at \$9.50 per bag directly from the show office and may be ordered in advance on the entry form and returned along with your stall reservations and/or entries. Orders needed prior to Sunday, June 23, must be requested no later than 4:00 P.M. on Thursday, June 20 by calling Dan Shirley (864-630-1669) or Janie Hamilton (214-478-0897). Beginning on Sunday, June 23, all orders must be in the show office prior to 10:00 A.M. for same day delivery. No outside bedding allowed.
- 5. Payment:** Exhibitors wishing to pay their show account individually must complete a separate entry form to set up a separate account and furnish their Social Security Number or Tax ID Number.
- 6. Refunds:** Entry fee refunds requested prior to the entry closing date (June 25) will be made in full (less the non-refundable office fee of \$25.00 per horse). After the closing date, entry fees will be refunded only with a veterinarian's certificate. Exhibitors may enter other classes, but no entry fee will otherwise be refunded. Stall fees are not refundable.
- 7. Scratches:** Scratches must be made in the show office by 9:00 A.M. for morning performances and during regular office hours for evening performances.
- 8. Office Hours:** The show office will be open from 9:00 A.M. to 5:30 P.M. on Monday (June 24). Packets will be available by 1:00 P.M. Tuesday, the office will open at 9:00 A.M. Office Hours will be posted for the remainder of the show.
- 9. Box Seats and Ringside Parking:** Contact Janie Hamilton at 214-478-0897 to reserve a Box Seat or Ringside Parking Spot. Box Seats (6 seats) and Ringside Parking Spots cost \$150.00.
- 10. Camper Hook-Up:** Limited Camper sites are available on the show grounds for \$45.00 per day. Please make reservations by calling Dan Shirley (864-630-1669) or Janie Hamilton (214-478-0897). The Chattanooga/North Cleveland KOA Campgrounds are located at 648 Pleasant Grove Road, Cleveland, Tennessee 37353 (one mile down the road from the show grounds). For reservations call 800-562-9739.
- 11. Qualifying Classes will be Split as Follows:** Academy classes will be split at 12, ten and under classes will be split at 12, driving classes will be split at 15, junior exhibitor classes will be split at 15, and all other classes will be split at 25.
- 12. Request for Holds:** For the benefit of all exhibitors, please place your hold request in advance of each session. Emergency holds will be accepted by the Paddock Master.
- 13. Negative Coggins:** A negative Coggins must accompany each horse (current within one year of the show). Proof will be required when picking up back numbers. If possible, please send a copy with entries to expedite office time.
- 14. Horse Soundness:** All horses and ponies must be serviceably sound. In case of suspected unsoundness, the judge may, if he so desired, have the horse or pony examined by the show veterinarian, and his decision will be final. No exhibitor may use a Veterinarian's Statement to contradict the judge's decision.
- 15. Dress:** All riders, drivers, attendants, and grooms shall be neatly and appropriately dressed upon entering the ring.
- 16. Ring Procedures:** The gate to the show ring will remain open two minutes after the first horse enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Please cooperate by being on time. Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls over that system

must be considered a courtesy. Therefore, no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed due to a PA malfunction.

17. Discipline: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge, or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver, or attendant shall be grounds to disqualify the horse. The owner shall forfeit the entry fee and other fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified horse.

18. Show Ring: No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitors and those having official or requested duties to perform.

19. Warm Up and Show Ring Courtesy: Exhibitors and trainers are cautioned as to their conduct in and around the show and warm up rings, especially in respect to schooling of horses. Items such as Balloons, Helium Items, Chains, Tape Measures, Blow Horns, Aerosol Cans, Split Bamboo Poles, Fireworks, Fire Extinguishers, or Whips Longer than six Feet that would alter or disturb the performance of a horse are prohibited.

20. Protests: Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the rules stated herein, the same shall be referred to the show management whose decision will be final. The show management will act as steward when any rule needs to be reviewed for clarification. In the event of a protest, the fee of \$100.00 will be payable to the Cleveland Tri-State Charity Horse Show and is not refundable.

21. Liability: The Cleveland Tri-State Charity Horse Show and the Tri-State Exhibition Center, Inc. will not be responsible for any accident, theft, damage, or injury occurring at the facility. The show committee of the Cleveland Tri-State Invitational Horse Show, the Tri-State Exhibition Center, Inc., the Equine Sports Council, nor any volunteer or sponsor will be responsible for any accident which may occur to any owner, vendor, spectator, driver, rider, groom, attendant, animal, or equipment at the show. Each rider exhibits at their own risk. *Warning: Under Tennessee law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, title 44, chapter 20, part 1.*

22. Equine Sports Council Rules: The Cleveland Tri-State Invitational Horse Show will be governed by the Equine Sports Council. A copy of the most current rulebook is available at equinesportscouncil.org.

23. Parking: All trucks, vans, trailers, and RVs, after unloading, must park in designated parking areas. All aisles and roadways around barns or tents must be kept open at all times. No recreational vehicles or trailers will be allowed to hook up to electrical outlets in the stall areas.

24. Pets: All pets on the grounds must be on a leash and under control at all times.

25. Stable Area: Gas, electric, or propane heaters; propane tanks; and hot plates are prohibited in the stable area. All electrical extension cords must be 12 gauge, 3 wire and prong negative type.

26. Manure: All manure and used shavings removed from the stalls or trailers must be placed in the manure pit or specified areas.

27. Barn Aisles and Doorways: Barn aisles and doorways must remain clear at all times. Stall guards on each stall must be closed and latched when unattended.

28. Smoking: No smoking is allowed in any building, restroom, or stable areas.

ASB FINE HARNESS DIVISION

To be shown at an animated walk, park trot and “Show Your Horse”, except in the Amateur class (where the animated walk and park trot are the required gaits). Horses to wear full mane and tail and to be shown to an appropriate four-wheel vehicle.

ASB PARK DIVISION

The Saddlebred Park horse should be stylish with finish and quality and well-mannered. High action is not required, but the performance should be animated and graceful in all gaits. Horses shown in any class of this division are ineligible to show in the Saddlebred Performance division or the Saddlebred Pleasure division at the same show. To be shown with a full mane and tail at a walk, trot, and canter.

The Saddlebred Three-Gaited Park Pleasure Horse should be stylish with finish and quality and well mannered. Open to mares and geldings shown by professionals and amateurs, the performance should be animated and graceful at all gaits. Horses shown in any class of this division are ineligible to show in the Saddlebred Performance or the Saddlebred Pleasure Divisions at the same show. To be shown with a full mane and tail at a flat walk, trot and canter. All entries in the division are required to back. Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% on total conformation.

AMERICAN SADDLEBRED-TYPE PONY DIVISION

American Saddlebred-type ponies should resemble the American Saddlebred as closely as possible. They need not be registered with the American Saddlebred Registry. American Saddlebred-type ponies are restricted to mares and geldings not to exceed 14.2 hands ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Measurement cards must be available on request or pony should be available for measurement should any question arise.

To be shown by an Adult Amateur or Junior Exhibitor. To be judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% on total conformation. Entries must stand quietly and back readily in the line-up. Horses showing in Show Pleasure cannot cross enter in the American Saddlebred Country Pleasure classes and vice versa except in Pleasure Equitation classes.

Horses showing in Country Pleasure cannot cross enter in the American Saddlebred Show Pleasure classes and vice versa except in Pleasure Equitation classes.

A stock choker or four-in hand tie with any color shirt is correct. Formal attire consists of a hunter shadbelly with buff or canary breeches, stock tie, canary vest, top hat and hunt boots. Formal attire is optional for all female competitors after 6:00 p.m. or in Championship classes. Protective headgear may be worn without penalty. In Hunter Pleasure classes the length of toe must not exceed 5” including pad and shoe.
